Public Health Messages

- Adults with learning disabilities 10 times more likely to have serious sight problems than other people.
- They may not know they have a sight problem and may not be able to tell other people
- 6 in 10 adults may need to wear glasses and often need support to wear their glasses
- Have an test every 2 years or more often if you optician tells you too



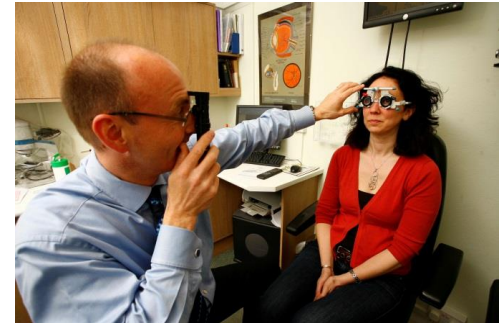
