



After the session everyone agreed they had a great time and would like to have it on the agenda for the future.




Changing Places

4. Update on Partnership Board

Topics – Accommodation and Health

Changing Places – these have been updated and there are two in Loughborough, one at Twycross Zoo and one at Bradgate Park. A lot of money has been put into the pot for Changing Places to enable more to be made available.

Equipment – Magda informed everyone that equipment is available for those who need extra assistance around their home.



- Flu screening
- Dementia
- Accommodation and Health for older adults
- Choosing where to live



Discussion took place about changes within the NHS and the future long term plan. Magda explained that this will include Liaison Nurses (someone who will explain to you what is happening when you to the hospital for your appointment). The Liaison Nurse will have a copy of your Grab Sheet so it is very important that you (or the person who cares for you) keeps your information at your GP Surgery up to date.

Harry said that GP Surgeries are making people wait a long time which is very annoying and feels this should be reduced.

It was suggested to speak to the Nurse at the Surgery so they can put this concern on the computer for when you have to wake an appointment.

Whole Life Disability Strategy – it has taken 2 years to put together this paper and there will be some Planning Groups coming together to discuss this. Warm Homes

- GP visits
- Help with better quality of life
- Help with completing applications for grants and funding if you are on low income or benefits.
- Managing energy bills better
- Funding for loft insulation, cavity wall insulation and boiler
